Learning catalan

Around 1773, the German philosopher J.G. von Herder published an essay in which he developed the relationship between the concept of 'national character' and the language and literature of a nation.

While this is only an introduction, what is true is that the command of a country's language is the fundamental tool to belong to its society on a normal and full basis.

Through the Departament de Cultura's *Parla.cat* channel, the government of the Generalitat provides the public with a tool that makes it easy to learn Catalan, while the *MónCat Portal* provides access to users who live abroad so they can keep the link with their country alive, making it easier for them to return.

What does the Portal offer?

Parla.cat itself illustrates its content in the DEMO section (it is highly advisable to visit this section)

To give a very brief summary, the channel's resources are focused on learning Catalan, regardless of the previous level of knowledge of the language.

The channel offers formally structured courses that match the accredited levels of knowledge of the language, while also offering a space for meeting and interaction between users, as well as a series of educational resources to facilitate both teaching and learning.

How is the Portal used?

Bear in mind that it is not possible to access the *Parla.cat* resources directly, rather you need a personal password that can be obtained quickly and easily through the channel itself.

Just go to the registration section and enter the password of your choice, as well as the other details requested on the form.

You will immediately receive an e-mail asking you to confirm your registration by following a certain link.

Once you have done this, your password will be activated and you will be able to use all the *Parla.cat* resources, in any of the five languages in which it is available.
